Located on the northeastern side of Oahu, it is less than an hour from Honolulu. The ranch terrain varies from dense rainforest to broad open valleys and from beautiful white sand beaches to verdant cliff faces. The ranch has been the site of many television shows and Hollywood films such as *Jurassic Park*, *Windtalkers*, *Pearl Harbor*, *Godzilla*, *Tears of the Sun* and *50 First Dates*. TV shows include *Hawaii Five-O*, *Magnun P.I.* and *Lost*. It is truly a paradise for outdoor recreation with many places accessible with horseback, on tour bus or by hiking.
